



“EXHIBITOR RULES”

1. A Horse, Youth or Non-Pro must be signed up with the Farwest Point Secretary or Show Secretary **prior** to the class in which he or she wants points to count in that particular show. For Breed Category Awards the registration fee is \$20.00 per category. Individual Class registration will be \$10.00. You will need to send in your points to the Point Secretary within 45 days of the show for each show location (not judge). You must be A MEMBER OF THE FARWEST CLUB.
B System Category Awards the registration fee is \$10.00 per category. You will need to send in your points to the Points Secretary within 45 days of the show each show location (not judge). YOU MUST BE A MEMBER OF THE FARWEST CLUB.
2. Points for Horse and Non-Pro awards will be awarded first through **tenth** as follows: 1st place – 11 points; 2nd place – 9 points, 3rd place – 8 points, etc. In a class of 5 horse: 1st/6pts; 2nd/4pts; 3rd/3pts, etc. In a class of 4 horses: 1st/5pts; 2nd/3pts; 3rd/2pts, etc. 1 horse class – ½ Farwest point only.
3. Youth points shall be tabulated the same as #2, and be awarded down to a 1 horse class. As points are credited to the Youth rider rather than the horse, the Youth may ride different horses.
4. In Halter the Grand Champion of each sex division shall receive two additional points more than any other horse in its age and sex division. The Reserve Champion of each sex division shall receive one additional point more than any other horse in its age and sex division.
5. In case of a tie for Farwest awards, the Horse, Non- Pro and Youth which has the greater number of 1st places shall be declared the winner. If there is still a tie, the most 2nd places and so on. In Halter classes only, the first method of breaking a tie shall be the most Grand Championships, if still tied the most Reserve Champions, then 1st, etc.
6. Year-End awards shall go to owner-lessee of horse at time of registration with Farwest. Transfer of ownership shall not affect the accumulation of horse points, however notification of transfer must be sent to the Farwest Point Secretary. Awards shall be given to new owner, if notice is received in writing from new owner and seller at least 45 days in advance of banquet.
7. Points earned as a Stallion count only in the Stallion category. If gelded a horse must be re-signed up as a Gelding and points shall start to accumulate in the Gelding category.
8. You must show is at least one Washington ApHC show per the bylaws to qualify for awards.

“BREED SHOW PERPETUAL AWARDS”

Points cannot be combined between Open, Non-Pro and Youth. One Horse/One Rider combination. Points will be tabulated in each category, then awarded to the Open Horse, Non-Pro Horse or Youth with the highest number of points earned.
